#### Description of Course:

This course is designed for professionals already providing clinical supervision in an addictions treatment, prevention, or mental health setting. Material covered will include: 1) Decision making process in determining the type of supervisory method used for specific supervisee development stages; 2) Navigating ethical dilemmas encountered by supervisees; 3) Setting up and facilitating team meetings; and, 4) Using technology in direct observation.

- 1) Be able to match a supervision modality most congruent with specific counselor development stages.
- 2) Understand the ethical decision making process.
- 3) Become comfortable with direct observation techniques.
